COVID-19 Symptoms Tracking Log for School Clinic

This log is to help keep track of anyone who presents to the clinic with COVID-19 symptoms. Symptoms of COVID-19 may include, but are not limited to, fever (100.4°F or higher), cough, shortness of breath, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion, runny nose, nausea, vomiting and diarrhea (always check CDC's website for the most updated list of symptoms).

- Use a ✓ (check mark) to indicate symptoms and interventions.
• Document all in Skyward at time of visit or within 24 hours.
• Under "Called" list who was notified: "A" Administration, "P/G" Parent/Guardian.
• Check Isolation if student was sent to isolation room until parent/guardian pick up.
• Be sure to communicate any trends of symptoms, absentees and actions taken with appropriate school district staff as well as the local county health department.
