 - **Tuesday** – HIGH FIVE TUESDAY give high fives to five people you don't know.
 - **Wednesday** – SHOW YOU CARE by asking three people about how their day is going.
 - **Thursday** – COMPLIMENT A STRANGER – Try to compliment someone you don't know and then if you receive a compliment write it down near the cafeteria during lunch.
 - **Friday** – TIE DYE FOR DIVERSITY – wear Tie Dye clothes to show you accept anyone regardless of how they look.
