6. Extended Day Enrichment Program (EDEP) Fees for 2014-15 School Year (Lagotic)

A proposed EDEP fee increase is recommended to continue to meet the needs of the children enrolled. The proposed weekly fee increase for full-time students will go from \$40 to \$48, and for free lunch students it will increase from \$17 to \$20.

7. Approval of Head Start Budget Amendment (Crowell)

A request to amend the Head Start budget is being submitted to the Administration for Children & Families to allow for the purchase of 15 computers and accessories. The unobligated balance from the 2012-13 budget, in the amount of \$13,527, will be used to improve program operations by replacing older computers with newer, more efficient technology.
