6. OPPAGA School Safety and Security Best Practices Report (Sumner)

Section 1006.07(6), Florida Statutes, requires school districts to use the Office of Program Policy Analysis and Government Accountability (OPPAGA) to conduct an annual self-assessment of the District's safety and security programs for Board approval, and within 30 days following Board approval, submit the report to the Commissioner of Education.

7. <u>Meadowbrook Elementary School Blanket Utility Easement with Gainesville Regional Utilities</u>
(Andrew)

A perpetual blanket easement between the School Board of Alachua County (Grantor) and Gainesville Regional Utilities (Grantee) for the purpose of construction, operating and maintaining municipal public utilities at Meadowbrook Elementary School, 11525 NW 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Gainesville, Florida. Tax Parcel No. 4211-003-003.

8. <u>Certificate of Final Inspection for Project SBAC D1106</u>—Stephen Foster Elementary School Erosion Repair (Andrew)

This project has been inspected by the project engineer and the Facilities Department staff. It is requested that the School Board authorize final payment to the contractor, upon total acceptance of this project. Final contract amount is \$37,742.94.

9. <u>Certificate of Final Inspection for Project SBAC S1204</u>—Gainesville High School Media Center Floor Repair (Andrew)

This project has been inspected by the Facilities Department staff. It is requested that the School Board authorize final payment to the contractor upon total acceptance of this project. Final contract amount is \$19,716.25.

10. <u>Agreement with the City of Gainesville/Gainesville Police Department (GPD) for the School</u> Resource Officer Program **(Caudle)** 

A contract has been prepared for submission to the City of Gainesville through its Police Department for the continuation of the School Resource Officer Program. This is an agreement whereby GPD will provide eleven (11) School Resource Officers to local schools and centers for the 2013-2014 school year. A total of up to \$297,039.60 will be paid by the School Board of Alachua County to GPD for eleven School Resource Officers to provide public safety and prevention and intervention education programs at specified schools.
