CONSUMABLE MATERIALS

(consumable – an item that cannot be reused after a lab activity)



Examples of Consumable Items:

Chemicals Dissecting Animals

Disposable Gloves Owl Pellets Glassware Beans/Seeds

Plastic Wrap, Foil Soil

Plastic Baggies Fertilizer

Q-Tips, Cotton Balls
Balloons
Agar
Disposable Pipettes
Food Coloring
pH Test Strips
Litmus Paper
Toothpicks

Straws Corn Starch, Salt, etc.

Filters Cooking Oil Glass Marking Pencils Gelatin

The following items **CANNOT** be ordered with consumable funds:

Food items (anything which can be eaten cannot be ordered)

Office supplies such as markers, tape, paper clips, etc.

Equipment such as balances, microscopes, lenses, etc.

Batteries

Calculators

Hardware such as bolts, nuts, washers, nails, screws, etc.

Science fair materials

Anything for another subject area

Anything electrical (light bulbs, motors, etc.)

Clothing such as lab coats or aprons that are not disposable (however, you can order cheap disposable aprons, gloves, goggles, etc.)

Wall thermometers (they are considered equipment)

Paper products (paper towels, paper plates, paper cups, plastic spoons, etc.)

All consumable orders <u>MUST</u> be submitted by Thursday, April 30, 2016
