

SCHOOL CHOICE-CONTROLLED OPEN ENROLLMENT

- Application deadline February 28, 2018
- Parents may apply for School Choice to any schools in the district
- Apply for up to three schools, ranked in order of preference
- Placement decisions will be subject to the priorities outlined in School Choice Policy 5120.03
- Once a child is approved and enrolled in a school under School Choice-Controlled Open Enrollment, he/she may remain through the terminal grade in the school without reapplying.

Under Capacity Schools

The following schools have projected enrollments under 90% of capacity and qualify for Controlled Open Enrollment under Florida Statutes F.S. 1002:

Elementary Schools: Duval (K only), Lake Forest, Metcalfe, Rawlings, Shell, Irby, and Alachua

Middle Schools: Mebane, Lincoln, Howard Bishop, and Hawthorne Middle-Senior

High Schools: Eastside, Santa Fe, and Hawthorne Middle-Senior

Over Capacity Schools

In all other schools, students who apply by the deadline will either be granted admission or placed on the waiting list through the random lottery process described in School Choice Policy 5120.03.
