- Bobcats, please join me in congratulating Team 49759A "Lynx Rufus" on their epic win at the "Kraken Klash" regional tournament in Tampa! Adrian P. is the lead engineer and Notebooker on the team and has put in tremendous work and effort on this bot! Teammate Eddie Y. also attended the competition on Saturday with him. Other members of Lynx Rufus include Karm B. and Isa V., who have been working on the bot this whole semester. They were undefeated in their 8 qualifying matches, earning them a 2nd rank seed for the elimination tournament. They also survived all the knockout rounds and triumphed in the final match, earning them the title of Tournament Champions and a qualification bid to the Regional Championship in February. They also received the "Amaze Award" from the judges, which is based on both tournament performance, as well as a judging interview and engineering notebook review. (Their Notebook is 100 pages long so far!) The Amaze Award recognizes a consistently high-performing and competitive robot. Key criteria of the Amaze Award are:
 - o Robot reliably contributes to high-scoring matches with their alliance partners.
 - Robot performs at a high level in Driving Skills and Autonomous Coding Skills at the event.
 - Programming is effective at solving the game challenges for both Qualification Matches and Skills Challenge matches.
 - Students understand and explain how they worked together to develop their robot design to consistently execute an effective game strategy.
 - Team Interview demonstrates effective communication skills, teamwork, professionalism, and a student-centered ethos.
 - The Engineering Notebook is consistent with the qualities demonstrated in the team interview and robot design.
