

Site Concerns & Opportunities

- Traffic flow along NE 9th Street.
- School currently floods during heavy rain. Please check the grading of sidewalks.
- Make sure the garden stays! The soil has been worked for 20 years, such a vital space for kids.
- Would like more thought given to community school.
- How can the design of the school be about space for kids to inhabit courtyards, outdoor classrooms, PE and arts.
- Tech teachers would like to be involved in interior construction storage, etc.
- Community center still in administration building F (expand to local residents participation).
- Café needs to have damped acoustics, kids get too amped after a loud lunch.

Historic & Cultural & Neighborhood Opportunities:

- Keep the neighborhood feel.
- What about the garden that has been worked on for 20 or more years?
- Historical 19 years of building soil in garden by volunteers.
- Be thoughtful of how two-story building affects neighbors.

- Long-term beauty, short-term inconvenience and cost.

Design & Construction Scheduled:

- Make the building more ecological/green so kids can learn from the design. Incorporate ways kids can study and monitor the building.
- Before thoughts for designing updating quad-amphitheater ground/material varies.
- Love the cafetorium being by the bus area.
