- The use of AI and ChatGPT software or similar programs is strictly prohibited.
- The essay must not exceed 750 words.
- A completed entry form must be returned with your essay.
- Previous winners may not apply.
- Essays received after the deadline will not be considered.

- First place winner will receive a \$1,500.00 scholarship for the Florida college or technical career institution of their choice. The selected essay will be published in the association's newsletter, and the winner will be recognized at the President's dinner during the FBC-LEO Spring Conference on February 27, 2025.
