We also have a responsibility to protect our students' data. We encourage the use of centrally supported and approved software tools through student single sign-on portal to ensure that our student data is appropriately protected. Centrally supported and approved tools are those for which we have negotiated terms of service to ensure, among other things, the appropriate protections for privacy of our students' data.

We realize that the educational software market is evolving rapidly. We also recognize that teachers want to creatively use additional technology tools in support of student engagement and student outcomes, and we support these efforts.

To remain compliant with federal laws including COPPA and FERPA, and protect the privacy of your students' data, please obtain parental consent when using a tool that is not on the district approved apps list or for apps on the list that require parental consent. The attached Parental Consent template should be used whenever using an online software tool.

## What Should You Do?

- 1. Complete the attached Parental Consent form by including:
  - The name of the app or website that you would like to use in the classroom
  - The purpose of the app or website
  - The website URL
  - The information that the website collects (or a link to it's privacy policy and terms of service)
  - Your contact information
- 2. Collect signed permission forms from your students
- 3. Retain the signed permission forms for the duration of the school year

## What should You Do if you do NOT receive signed permission?

Teachers should be prepared to make equivalent educational opportunity available if parental consent is not obtained.
