



## Florida Best and Brightest 2019-2020 \*Recognition Award AMOUNT TO BE DETERMINED (Non-Instructional)

School Based Support Personnel Eligible for the Recognition Award: Media Aides, Student Services Specialist, Para I General, Para I Instructional, Para II Behavioral, Para II Instructional, Para II ESE, Para II Non-Instructional, and Para III

- 1. Eligible Support Personnel will receive **one-third** of the Recognition Award amount provided to instructional bargaining unit members.
- 2. The Recognition Award will be for the remaining allocated funds after the Recruitment, Retention and Principal Bonus awards have been distributed.
- 3. S. 1011.62 (18), F.S., provides that if a district's calculated awards exceed the allocation, the school district may **PRORATE** awards.

## **School Based Student Support Personnel**

Student Support Personnel MUST hand deliver or truck mail application and a copy of their 2018-2019 evaluation to Human Resources by October 11, 2019.

\*The Florida Legislature has revised the Best and Brightest Scholarship Award for 2019-2020.

Criteria for the Recognition Award has been established in partnership with the District and ACEA through the Collective Bargaining Process.

## **Recognition Award**

- ⇒ The Recognition Award will be given to qualifying Support Personnel who worked at least 0.5 FTE during the 2018-2019 school year AND
- ⇒ Any school-based paraprofessional who was evaluated in 2018-2019 and received no more than two "not met's" on their evaluation will be deemed "effective", and will be eligible to receive one-third of the Recognition Award amount provided to instructional bargaining unit members.

If a school-based paraprofessional was not evaluated during the 2018-2019 school year, they will be deemed effective and be eligible to receive **one-third** of the Recognition Award amount provided to the instructional bargaining unit members.
