4:03 A motion was made to approve the agenda. Motion seconded and approved.

4:04 A motion was made to approve the April 1, 2021 minutes. Motion seconded and approved.

2021-22 school ADS, ADV, and 0IB budget projections have not been received. 2020-21 SAC/ADS expenditures have been less than previously projected and approved.

EHS Site Tech will be crucial this Summer. Computers will need to be reimaged and set up. All digital equipment to be used next school year will need to be prepared. The work schedule this Summer is shortened due to the late ending of the 2020-21 school year. SAC/ADS budget typically pays for two instructional teacher positions annually.

ADS funding is distributed to the SAC and ADS expenditures must be approved by the the SAC, and ADV and 0IB funding is distributed to the school for expenditures.

4:10 A motion was made to approve the SAC ADS 2021-22 Expenditure Request (School Year 2021-22 Salary Proposal for SAC/ADS to fund two teacher positions for the 2021-22 school year and a Summer 2021 Site Tech), it was seconded and unanimously approved.

4:12 A motion was made to elect and approve nominated individuals to the EHS SAC for a two year term (2021-22 & 2022-23 school years), it was seconded, and unanimously approved.

The SAC budget has been fairly static this school year. The roll forward amount and the SAC budget will be shared again after the beginning of the new fiscal year (which starts on July 1, 2021). The roll forward amount may be substantial higher than the past 5 years due to careful management by administration.
