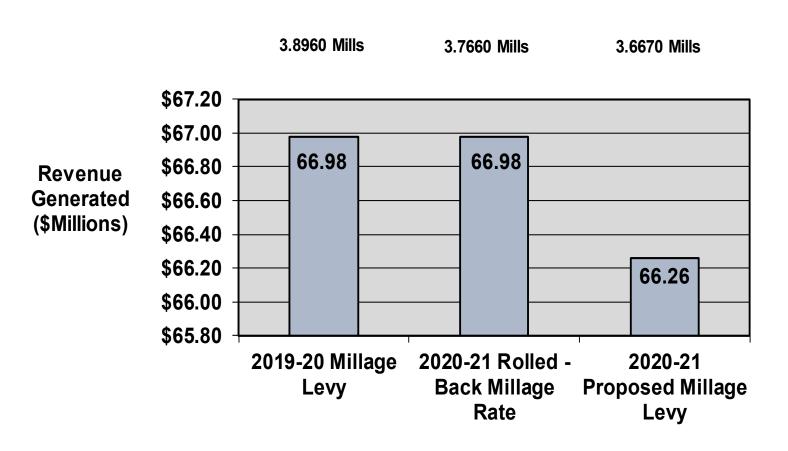

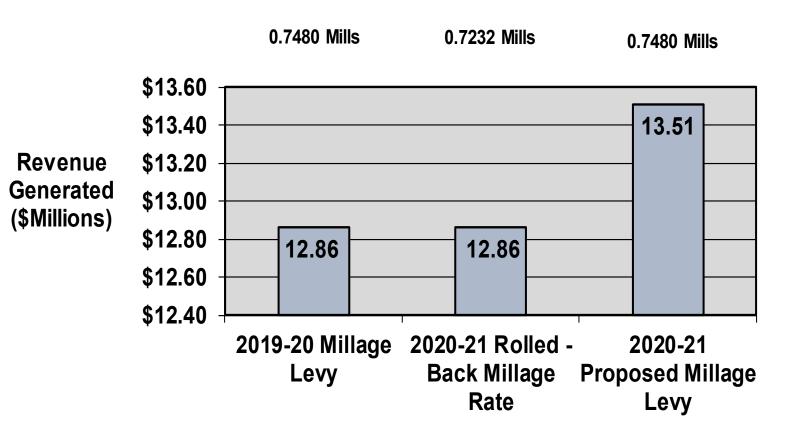
### Rolled-Back Millage Rate

Rolled-Back Millage is a Computed Millage Rate That When Applied to the New Tax Roll Generates the Same Tax Revenue as the Prior Year.

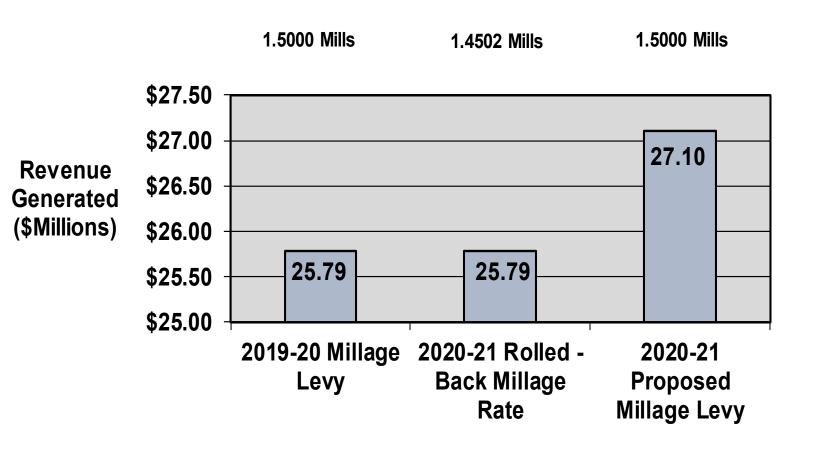
#### Required Local Effort (RLE)



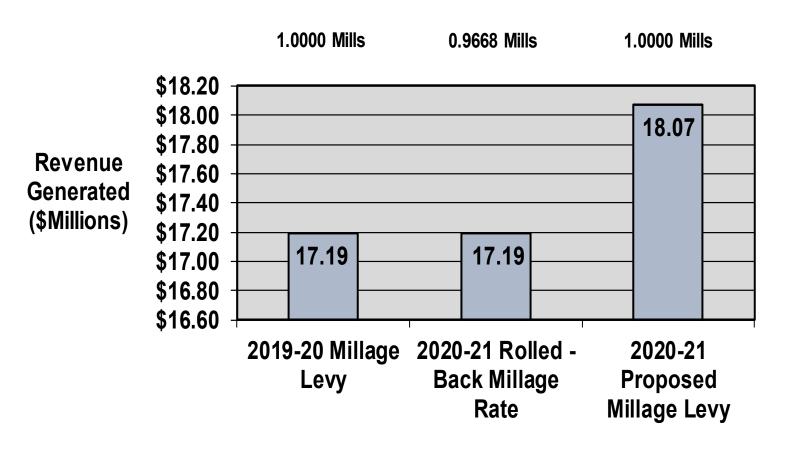
#### **Discretionary Operating**



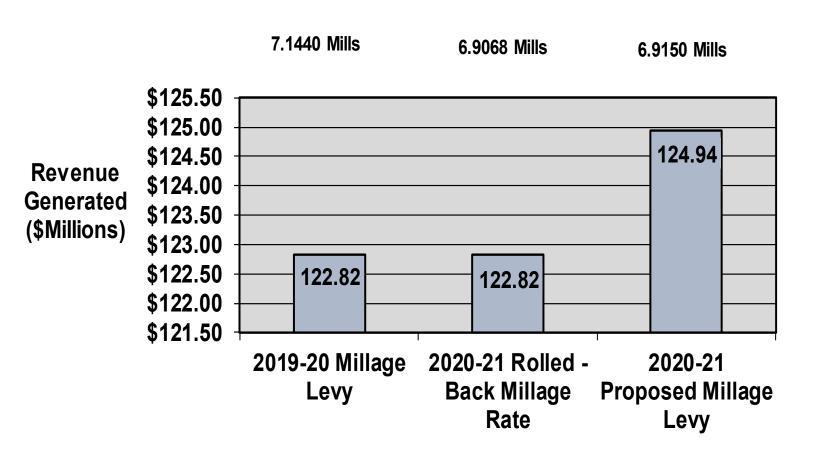
#### **Capital Outlay**

# Millage Impact on Taxpayer for Education

#### **Assessment Increases:**

If the market value of a home exceeds the assessed value, the assessment will automatically increase by the consumer price index (CPI) or a maximum of 3% per year. For 2020 the CPI is 2.3%. Therefore, the maximum increase in assessment for 2020, assuming no improvements to a home, would be 2.3%.

# Resolution Number 21-03 FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION RESOLUTION DETERMINING REVENUES AND MILLAGES LEVIED

RESOLUTION OF THE DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARD OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA, DETERMINING THE AMOUNT OF REVENUES TO BE PRODUCED AND THE MILLAGE TO BE LEVIED FOR THE GENERAL FUND, FOR THE DISTRICT LOCAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND AND FOR DISTRICT DEBT SERVICE FUNDS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2020, AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2021.

WHEREAS, section 1011.04, Florida Statutes, requires that, upon receipt of the certificate of the property appraiser giving the assessed valuation of the county and of each of the special tax school districts, the school board shall determine, by resolution, the amounts necessary to be raised for current operating purposes and for debt service funds and the millage to be levied for each such fund, including the voted millage; and

WHEREAS, section 1011.71, Florida Statutes, provides for the amounts necessary to be raised for local capital improvement outlay and the millage to be levied; and

WHEREAS, the certificate of the property appraiser has been received;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the district school board that the amounts necessary to be raised as shown by the officially adopted budget and the millages necessary to be levied for each school fund of the district for the fiscal year are as follows:
