Set aside time each day for homework and chores. You may want to use a calendar to keep track of due dates and tasks.

INVOLVEMENT and SUPPORT

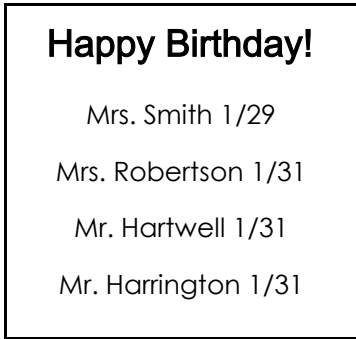
