Differentiated Pay Educational Enrichment Allocation Memorandum of Understanding between ACEA and Alachua County Public Schools

Both parties agree that differentiated pay will be awarded to instructional personnel, including instructional paraprofessionals at Educational Enrichment Allocation eligible schools for the 2023-2024 school year for the purposes of recruitment and retention.

A \$1,250 payment will be made in January 2024 to all active instructional staff members of Idylwild and Lake Forest Elementary Schools who have missed five or fewer days of work in the first semester. A second \$1,250 payment will be awarded in June 2024 to all active instructional personnel at these schools who have missed five or fewer days of work in the second semester.

A \$500 payment will be made in January 2024 to all active instructional paraprofessionals of Idylwild and Lake Forest Elementary Schools who have missed five or fewer days of work in the first semester. A second \$500 payment will be awarded in June 2024 to all active instructional paraprofessionals at these two schools who have missed five or fewer days of work in the second semester. Bonuses will be funded out of the Educational Enrichment Allocation funds as allowable under the grant application and then covered by district funds to bring all designated employees up to the bonus amounts prescribed in this memorandum of understanding.

This agreement is in place for the 2023-2024 School Year.
