- Florida School Counseling Association Scholarship (FSCA): Deadline, Friday, April 26<sup>th</sup>. FSCA will award four high school scholarships in the amount of \$250 each; one of the four scholarships (\$250) will be awarded to a son or daughter of a FSCA member (membership of 6 months or longer). Child of a FSCA Member must provide the FSCA members name and User ID. The application requires a 250-500 words response to: *How do school counselors and school counseling programs positively impact students and their success?* High School student criteria: 1) Be enrolled in a Florida High School, in 12<sup>th</sup> grade, 2) on track to graduate either during the current spring or summer and, 3) intend to enroll in a postsecondary institution in the upcoming summer or fall following high school graduation.
