ADDITIONAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Submit a complete Florida Financial Aid Application (FFAA), also known as the State Application (no later than August 31st of their senior year).
2. Complete the required coursework by high school graduation date.
3. Achieve the required grade point average in the required coursework.
4. Complete the required number of service hours by high school graduation date.
5. Achieve the required college entrance exam score (no later than June 30 of your senior senior year).
