Bright Future's Scholarship Program & FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)

- **Bright Futures Eligibility Requirements**
 - 16 high school course credits – 4 English, 4 Math, 3 Science, 3 Social Studies, 2 World Language
 - Weighted GPA
 - College Entrance Exams – SAT or ACT
 - Community Service Hours – must be PRE-APPROVED in the Guidance office. All community service hours must be on transcript by graduation date
- **Bright Futures**--Register at www.FloridaStudentFinancialAid.org by **August 31, 2020**
- **FAFSA**—Register at www.FAFSA.ed.gov
- Both open **October 1, 2019**

College Applications

- Students should be checking the school's website for requirements and DEADLINES
- Determine if ACT and SAT scores are required and if the scores is within the required range
 - Plan to retake SAT or ACT if needed
- All ACT and SAT score must be sent directly to the college
- If Counselor recommendations are required, make an appointment with your counselor

Testing

- **ACT** - Test dates; register; view, interpret, and send scores; test prep: www.actstudent.org
- **SAT** - Test dates; register; view, interpret, and send scores; test prep: www.collegeboard.org

Deadlines

- **FSU** – November 1, 2019 (notification January 31); **UF** – November 1 (notification mid February);
- ALL other state universities have rolling admission – **APPLY EARLY**
